Petition Asks For U.S. Files On JFK Slaying

An organization called "We the People Speak of America, Inc." has begun a drive to obtain signatures for a petition asking that the complete files of the federal government on the assassination of President Kennedy be made public immediately. It is not addressed to any particular public official nor to Congress.

The group is led by William F. Gillen Jr., a New Orleans resident. Gillen spoke to the Young Men's Business Club today trying to build up support for his campaign.

GILLEN SAID he had not talked to anyone in government about his efforts.

He said his organization is two months old and so far has received about 8,000 to 9,000 signatures.
