atement Dodd said:

"Shortly after the East Bat-on Rouge district attorney's investigation began relative to telephone calls between the Town and Country Motel in Metairie, and the State Capitol, I informed Sarthere Pitcher that at least three calls came to my office and were taken by my secretary, Mrs. Ruth Stout.

"While I did not talk on these calls, they were taken by my secretary.
"These calls were made by

a lady who represented herself as a secretary who was calling to get my office to as-sist Joe Marcello in his ef-forts to have Louisiana State University in New Orleans accept the application of a student into that institution.

"MRS, STOUT will verify the fact that she talked on these calls and wrote a let-ter to Joe Marcello concerning these cals. And District Attorney Pitcher will verify the fact that we disclosed the same to him, and he checked them out and stated that they

were legitimate calls.

"In the four years that I have been state superintendent of education I have received several thousand calls of this nature and have tried

to assist, as best I could, stu-dents who have needed help." Pitcher confirmed that he had checked out the calls and said the reason he did not want to discuss the persons'
