

Male Jury Set to Hear Shaw Case

NEW ORLEANS — (UPI)

— An all-male panel of 12 jurors and two alternates was seated today to try Clay L. Shaw on charges of conspiring to murder President John F. Kennedy. Opening statements were set for tomorrow morning.

After the second alternate was sworn in before noon, District Judge Edward A. Haggerty Jr. sent the jury off for a group photograph. He dismissed court for the rest of the day.

The final alternate was Robert J. Burlet, president of a crane service.
