URGENT

NEW ORLEANS AP - Clay wl. Shaw, who was found innocent Saturday of charges that he conspired to murder President John F. Kennedy, was charged with two counts of perjury today by Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison.

Garrison's aides filed the complaint Monday afternoon in Criminal District Court here, charging that Shaw lied when he denied knowing Lee Harvey Oswald and David W. Ferrie.

A Criminal District Court jury returned a unanimous verdict of innocent early Saturday morning, freeing Shaw of the charge that he had plotted Kennedy's death with Oswald and Ferrie. Shaw denied at the trial that he had ever seen or knew Oswald or Ferrie, both now dead.

The official investigation into the assassination by the Warren Commission ruled that Oswald was the president's lone assassin.
