

Services Set For Nurse Miss Dreher

Funeral services will be held tomorrow for Miss Ida Rose Dreher, a nurse at Veterans Administration Hospital, whose body was found Saturday night at the foot of a stairway leading to her apartment. She was 43.

The rites will be held at 9 a.m. at the Lamana-Panno-Fallo funeral home, 625 N. Rampart. A Requiem Mass will follow at St. Louis Cathedral with interment in Hope Mausoleum.

A spokesman for the Orleans Parish Coroner's Office yesterday said Miss Dreher died of severe head injuries and had suffered numerous cuts and bruises. He said the case is under investigation.

Police detectives who conducted the initial investigation Saturday, theorized that Miss Dreher fell as she was descending the stairway while carrying a bag of trash. The bag was found alongside the body.

Miss Dreher, who had lived in New Orleans 26 years, was a graduate of the Charity Hospital School of Nursing and received her B.S. in nursing education from Louisiana State University.

She was a member of the Louisiana State Nurses Association, the National Council of Catholic Nurses and the Patio Planters.

Miss Dreher is survived by her mother, the former Maude Cleveland of Clinton; a sister, Miss Katie Dreher of New Orleans; and a brother, George Dreher of Clinton.
