

## Reset Trial<sup>1 Dec 70</sup> Of Gremillion For Feb. 8

Attorney General Jack P. F. Gremillion is now scheduled to go on trial Feb. 8 along with four other persons on fraud charges growing out of the bankruptcy of Louisiana Loan & Thrift Corp.

Federal District Judge Frederick J. R. Heebe today set the new trial date because, he said, Gremillion will be engaged during January in litigation involving the Louisiana-Texas border dispute in the Sabine River area.

The trial previously was scheduled for Jan. 18.

Judge Heebe also denied one Gremillion motion claiming immunity from prosecution and another asking that the fraud charges against Gremillion be consolidated with a previous perjury charge.

Gremillion's attorneys filed a motion asking dismissal of the indictment against him on grounds that the Louisiana Board of Ethics previously cleared him of the charge. No date was set for a hearing on the motion.
