Shaw, Syit Against DA Set for Trial

Trial of a \$5 million damage suit brought by Clay L. Shaw against Dist. Atty. Jim Garri-son and others has been set for June 18 by - U.S. District Court Judge Frederick J. R. Heehe

Shaw, a New Orleans businessman, was acquitted on charges of conspiring to assassinate President Kennedy. sassinate President Kennedy. His suit names as co-defendants Joseph M. Rault Jr., Cecil M. Shilstone and Willard Robertson, members of "Truth and Consequences."

The organization gave financial support to Carrison's in-

cial support to Garrison's investigation of the Kennedy as-

sassination.

Other defendants are Perry Raymond Russo, chief witness at the Shaw trial, and Dr. Esmond A. Fatter, who allegedly put Russo into an hallucinatory transe in order to alicit ry trance in order to elicit testimony implicating Shaw in

the death.

The suit charges Shaw's constitutional rights were violated as a result of a conspiracy between the defendants.
