Dear Mr. Hall,

I contacted your office in February 1983 concerning a Freedom of Information request about the investigations conducted in the Detroit area during the investigations following the assassination of President John Kennedy; and I was especially interested in material concerning a Mrs. Beck, who allegedly had a movie film she had taken of the assassination.


In May, I received a response from you that there were 750 pp of file material from the investigations conducted in the Detroit area, and costs would run \$.10 per page.

About 2 weeks later I wrote back and asked if I could order the material in increments, for example ordering the first 100 or 200 pp (in chronological order), and then the next 200 pp, etc. so as not to be too costly all at one time. I also mentioned that I was still particularly interested in anything pertaining to Mrs. Beck.

It has been 5 months now and I have not had a single word from your office. I am still interested in the material gathered in the Detroit area and wish to restate my request for copies under the FOIPA.

Please get back to me and let me know the status of my request. I still would like to know if I may order the documents in chronological increments, but if for some reason that is not permitted then I would like to have them all at once. I would appreciate your assistance in this matter, and your consideration. Thank you very much, and I look forward to hearing from you soon.
