MANY SOVIET BASES REPORTED IN CUBA

Miami - (CNS) - The mystery of widespread Soviet activity in Cuba remains unsolved, but detailed, circumstantial reports in refugee circles here say only a part of it revolves around Cienfuegos.

The Cienfuegos installation, whatever it amounts to, is only one link in a network of military facilities built in Cuba with Soviet help, whether or not for actual Soviet use.

Cuban exile intelligence sources have been reporting such activity for years, and actually called the shot on [the] base
