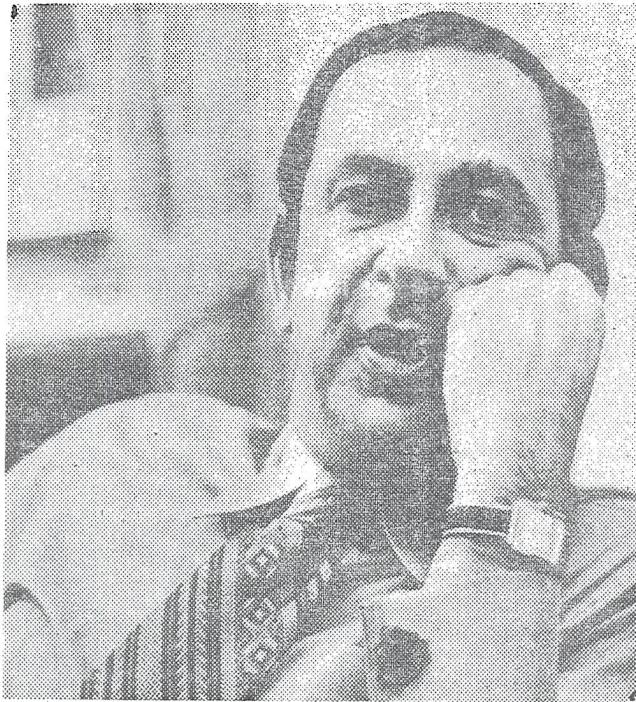


Mann Leaving U.S. Post for Bank

WASHINGTON, Nov. 18 (AP)—The resignation of Maurice Mann as assistant director of the Office of Management and Budget was announced today. He has had responsibility for economic affairs.

The office's director, George P. Shultz, said he accepted the resignation with regret. Mr. Mann, he added, resigned to take an executive post with a large East-

ern commercial bank. An announcement of the details is expected shortly. The resignation takes effect Nov. 30.

A native of Peabody, Mass., Mr. Mann is 41 years old and a graduate of Northeastern University, Boston. He received his doctorate from Syracuse University, where he also taught economics. He also was a member of the economics faculty at Ohio Wesleyan University.
