Agnew to Head U.S. Delegation To South Korea

Vice President Spiro Agnew was named by President Nixon yesterday to head a U.S. delegation at the inauguration of South Korean President Chung Hee Park on July 1 and to go on for a visit to eight countries in Asia, Europe, the Middle

East and Afrcia.

The White House said the June 26 - July 28 trip of the vice president will be to "demonstrate the President's continuing, personal interest in the countries involved and to develop first hand knowledge of their problems and progress."
