

60 in Virginia Protest Nixon's Plan for China Trip

RICHMOND, Va., July 22 (AP) — Nearly 60 persons, mostly middle-aged and older woman, paraded on Ninth Street outside Capitol Square here today in opposition to any accommodation by the United States with Communist China.

The march was a substitute for a rally the Rev. Carl McIntire, the radio preacher from Collingswood, N. J., had planned at the site of the old Bell Tower in the square.

Mr. McIntire made a speech against President Nixon's proposed visit to China from a telephone booth in the Capitol. He used the phone to record a broadcast, and his voice from the booth rang through the Capitol corridors.
