
NO CHINA TRIPS UNTIL NIXON VISIT

WASHINGTON — (CST) — Sen. Adlai E. Stevenson III said yesterday that the State Department has advised China against admitting any senators or congressmen prior to President Nixon's visit. He felt "sure" Peking would comply.

Stevenson (D-Ill.) indicated support for the State Department's policy and said he had passed the word to Peking that he did not think it would be "appropriate" for him to visit China until after Nixon's trip.

The senator applied for a visa a few hours before the President made his surprise July 15 announcement that he plans to go to China before next May.
