
Harris Poll On Nixon and The Economy

New York

Pollster Louis Harris said yesterday that President Nixon's rating on keeping the economy healthy has dropped to a new low of 22 per cent.

The Administration got a negative rating on economic policy from 73 per cent of the people interviewed, while 5 per cent were undecided, Harris said in a report.

Mr. Nixon's economic rating has plunged in recent months from a high of 35-60 in May, Harris said.

The latest poll showed that 62 per cent of the people feel the country is still in a recession, and 47 per cent don't think things will be better a year from now.

The Administration got a negative 77-16 per cent rating on its efforts to control unemployment, and 83 per cent negative on "keeping down the cost of living."
