

\$100,000 Fire Damages G.O.P. Phoenix Office

PHOENIX, Ariz., Sept. 29 (UPI) — An arson-set fire caused \$100,000 damage to Republican campaign headquarters here early today, just six hours after President Nixon's daughter, Mrs. David Eisenhower, dedicated a new Phoenix convention center.

Campaign literature, typewriters, disks and other office equipment throughout the two-story building housing the Committee to Re-Elect the President were destroyed or damaged beyond use.

Bob Biven, chief investigator for the Phoenix Fire Department, said that a flammable liquid had been used to start the blaze in a first floor hallway at about 2:30 A.M. The flames spread quickly, heavily damaging the lower level and causing smoke and heat damage upstairs. There were no injuries.
