Nixon Loses Election In Vote at Art Gallery

WASHINGTON, Nov. 14—
President Nixon lost the election—at an exhibit of Presidential losers at the National Portrait Gallery.

Visitors of all ages and countries cast ballots on a voting machine for the Presidential candidate they wanted to see lose in 1972. President Nixon easily led all contestants.

The President overwhelmed Gov. George C. Wallace of Alabama in the primary contest by nearly 2 to 1 in losing votes. Against Senator George McGovern, Mr. Nixon received 8,882 losing votes to 4,896 for Mr. McGovern.
