Nixon's Night of Dining and Dancing

Key Biscayne, Fla.

President Nixon went dining and dancing last night and took a startled 11-year-old girl for a spin around the dance floor.

The girl, Sherri Sexton, was having dinner with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Victor M. Sexton of Newport News, Va., in the Key Biscayne Hotel restaurant when the President arrived with his wife Pat, Florida neighbor C. G. (Bebe) Rebozo and Rebozo's companion, Jane Lucke.

After the presidential par-

ty was seated, Mr. Nixon sent Rebozo to ask the long-haired girl to dance. As the girl and Rebozo danced to the song "On the Street Where You Live," Mr. Nixon came to the dance floor and cut in.

The girl said later she was surprised but that the President put her at ease by talking about her school work and about Disneyland. The President, she said, "is a good dancer."

Mr. Nixon also danced with his wife and with Miss Lucke.
