Henry and Blonde Root for Redskins

Washington

Presidential adviser Henry Kissenger was among the record crowd of 53,140 fans yesterday who watched the Christmas Eve Washington-Green Bay divisional playoff game at RFK stadium.

He and his unidentified blonde date sat in the private box of Redskins owner Edward Bennett Williams along with other politicians and celebrities, including Maine Senator Edmund Muskie and Hall of Fame baseball star Joe Di-Maggio.

It was the largest crowd ever to watch a football game in Washington and the first National Football League playoff game in the capital city in 30 years.

The game was blacked out on television in Washington. Commissioner Pete Rozelle refused a request from President Nixon to lift the blackout and a last minute appeal to the supreme Court was rejected.
