Nixon's Lonely New Year's

WASHINGTON — (UPI)
— President Nixon was expected to spend a lonely
New Year's Eve at his
Camp David mountaintop
retreat with no family members around to ring in the
new year with him.

The First Lady planned to fly to California today to appear as a guest in the Rose Bowl parade on New Year's day. She will ride in an open

car behind actor John Wayne, parade grand marshal.

Mrs. Nixon will also attend luncheon hosted by her alma mater, the University of Southern California, with Governor Reagan and Ohio Gov. John Gilligan. She will sit on the USC side during the game.

Her return plans still are indefinite, and a spokesman

said she may remain in California for a day to two.

Mrs. Nixon will represent the President at memorial services for House Democratic leader Hale Boggs in New Orleans on Jan. 4. Boggs' plane disappeared during a campaign trip in Alaska in October.

The Nixon daughters and sons - in - law were on holiday in Greece and Russia.
