But administration offi-But administration officials said they foresaw no immediate change in U.S. policy toward Cuba, last stated by President Nixon shortly after his election when he said: "There will be no change... in our policy toward Cuba" until Fidel Castro "changes his policy toward Latin America."

Representative Charles Whalen (Rep-Ohio), a spokesman for the 12 GOP House members, said "the time is ripe to take appropriate steps to normalize re-lations with Cuba."

Whalen said the group recognized major issues, in-cluding the future of Guan-tanamo Naval Base, com-pensation for expropriated

U.S. holdings, the Cuban Sugar quota an the question of Cuban refugees would have to be negotiated before relations could be renewed.
