Nixon to Speak Tomorrow at University in Florida

Washington, June 6 (UPI) - President Nixon will deliver the commencement address Friday at 10:30 A.M. at Florida Technological University in Orlando, the White House announced today. The president will then fly to his home in Key Biscayne for the weekend.

Since April 30, when Mr. Nixon addressed the nation on the Watergate affair, he has made only three public appearances. He spoke at military installations in Mississippi and in Virginia, and to former prisoners of war at the State Department.

Secret Service agents were reported to be on the campus of Florida Tech, a state-supported school of about 6,000 students.

John Herbers, NYT 9 Jun 73, describes Nixon's speech as "his first before an outdoor civilian audience since his second inauguration in January," says invitation to speak here is a "two-year-old invitation," and that it was accepted only three days before. - NYTimes 9 Jun 73.
