Another high-level hold-over from the Nixon White House resigned yesterday, effective Dec. 31. He is Leonard Garment, a former member of Richard M. Nixon's law firm here and a White House assistant since 1969. Mr. Garment, who is 50 years old, handled projects in such areas as voluntary action, human and civil rights, and the arts. In accepting his resignation, President Ford thanked Mr. Garment for his help during the Presidential transition period. Mr. Garment is joining the New York law firm of Trubin, Sillocks, Edelman & Knapp.
