When President Nixon moved into the White House in 1969, he sold his 12-room cooperative apartment at 810 Fifth Avenue for a reported \$315,000, or \$189,000 more than he paid for it in 1963. Joseph A. Grotto, president of Brown, Harris, Stevens, Inc., agents for the building at 62d Street, said that he would not contradict a published report of sales price, paid by Lewis Edward Lehrman, the president of Rite Aid Corporation, of Shiremenstown, Pa.

"I don't think that's a very great price for an apartment where a president had lived," Mr. Grotto commented.
