WASHINGTON — (AP) — President Nixon's campaign director said today a \$25,000 campaign check linked to a key figure in the intrusion into Democratic headquarters was "properly and lawfully accounted for" by Republican finance officials.

Responding to questions at a National Press Club luncheon, Clark MacGregor said that, from his own investigation, he is satisfied that the \$25,000 check was cashed by Bernard Barker and the proceeds turned over to the campaign treasury.

MacGregor would not comment on a report in the Washington Star-News that additional contributions to Nixon's campaign totaling \$89,000 had found their way into Barker's bank account.

"I haven't had an opportunity to investigate the facts," MacGregor said.
