

## MacGregor Hocks McGovern Plans

Washington, Aug. 10 - Clark MacGregor, President Mixon's campaign director [speaking to the Mational Press Club, attacked the Democratic Presidential nominee with his own words today, imploring Senator George McGovern to "come home, George," from what he termed a "giveaway" welfare program, "massive and reckless" defense cuts and a "begging" foreign policy.

ratic National Headquarters in June by five men with eavesdropping equipment as "absolutely idiotic, wholly unauthorized and bizarre."
