GOP Lists \$488,000

From Small Donors

WASHINGTON — (UPI) — President Nixon's re-election campaign committee, in compliance with a consent order signed by a federal judge, released the names yesterday of 1284 small contributors who donated \$488,000 during a 15-month period ending March 9.

The list of contributors — ranging from actor John Wayne to Roy L. Ash, co-founder of Litton Industries — accounted for about 57 percent of the \$10.1 million which the Nixon campaign listed as "cash on hand" when a new campaign disclosure law took effect April 7.

The Nixon organization had previously identified 283 major contributors of more than \$1000 each which accounted for another \$4.9 million.

The \$5.4 million total still left secret the names of donors of at least \$4.7 million collected between March 9 and April 7.

The Nixon organization released its list of contributors of between \$100 and \$1000 yesterday in compliance with a consent order signed last week by U.S. District Judge Joseph C. Wady.
