Mitchell Calls Watergate Break-in

John N. Mitchell said yesterday he still believes — as he did last September — that the Watergate break-in was "a ridiculous caper that

the news media have blown all out of proportion."

Senator Joseph M. Montoya (Dem-N.M.) read that quotation to Mitchell from a news story and asked him if

he agreed with that characterization.

"Yes, sir, I do," Mitchell replied.

But he said he would not apply the "caper" label to
