WASHINGTON, July 24 (UPI)—Jack Valenti said to-day that President Johnson occasionally recorded his telephone conversations with-out knowledge of the other person but that no White House ofices were bugged during the Johnson Adminis-

during the Johnson Administration.

Mr. Valenti, a close aide to Mr. Johnson before becoming head of the Motion Picture Association, said that Mr. Johnson had "the equipment to roord phon calls, which he did selectively, particularly when he wanted to to record a decision he had made."

"But it was not automatic," he said in an interview on the NBC-TV "Today" show. "Nt had to be activated."

Asked if the other person would know about the taping, Mr. Valenti said, "Tomy knowledge, no."
