

ABC Man's Watergate Tapes Stolen

Watergate-related materials of an ABC News correspondent were stolen this month from his office at the ABC News building in Washington, the network said yesterday.

The theft was discovered August 10 by correspondent Bill Gill, according to John Lynch, manager of the ABC News bureau in Washington. He said it is not known when the theft happened.

He said the thieves stole five audio cassette tapes, one of which "had sensitive information he (Gill) had recorded as part of his investigation" of the Watergate case, as well as a manila folder containing Gill's notes on the case.
