NEW YORK (UPI)—Martha Mitchell tried Friday night to communicate with the Western White House on her husband's relationship with President Nixon, but she was told to "call UPI," she said.

"I'm so damned mad," Mrs. Mitchell, wife of former Attorney General John N. Mitchell told the UPI news desk in New York in a 3 a.m. telephone call. "I asked them to let me speak to the President. I wanted to tell him something. They told me, 'Tell it to UPI.'"

Mrs. Mitchell called Helen Thomas, who is in California covering the President's activities.
