The trial of John D. Ehrlichman and three other former White House aides on conspiracy and burglary charges was set yesterday of December 19.

The actual start of the trial, however, could be delayed well beyond that date by arguments over pretrial motions, including one expected from the defense seeking access to the presidential tapes.

Ehrlichman and Egil (Bud) Krogh, David Young and G. Gordon Liddy were indicted in connection with the 1971 break-in at the offices of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist by government agents seeking psychiatric data.
