

Store Repaid

For Agnew

Food Gifts

A Food Fair Store executive has repaid the company for gifts of food he regularly sent to former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew.

Jack Friedland, president of the supermarket chain, told an annual stockholders meeting that Joseph H. Rash, a corporate vice president, repaid the company for his gifts to Agnew after the company demanded reimbursement.

Friedland refused to reveal the exact amount but said Tuesday that it was "insignificant."

Baltimore radio station WFBR has said the gifts involved 273 consecutive weeks supply of food valued at more than \$6000.

Payment was based on the retail price of the food, Friedland said. Under questioning from a stockholder, Friedland said the management was not aware of Rash's actions. He added that there were no plans to fire Rash.
