Scott Calls '73

Worst Political Year

Senate Republican leader Hugh Scott said yesterday that 1973 has been "the worst year I've ever lived in a political sense," and expressed hope that 1974 will be better.

At a news conference for media of his home state of Pennsylvania, Scott touched on many Watergate-related matters including his efforts to get President Nixon to release more information to the public. He said it was "a matter I daily raise with the President . . . as much a part of my life as brushing my teeth."
