

# Plumbers' Trial Delayed

## Los Angeles

The trial of John Ehrlichman and two other former White House aides in the break-in of the office of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist was postponed yesterday until April 15.

Defense lawyers told Superior Court Judge Gordon Ringer they had a number of pre-trial motions for dismissal of charges which would take weeks to prepare.

Deputy District Attorney Stephen Trott also told the court he was not prepared to proceed at this time.

Trott said that a fourth former defendant, Egil (Bud) Krogh, would be one of the prosecution witnesses but that Krogh would not be available until he is sentenced in Washington after pleading guilty to violating the civil rights of the psychiatrist, Dr. Lewis Fielding.
