

Nixon's Return

Trip Also Will Be on Airliner

San Clemente

A White House spokesman said yesterday President Nixon will fly back to Washington aboard a commercial plane, the same way he flew out here.

"There are no plans for any government airplanes to come out here," deputy press secretary Gerald L. Warren told reporters.

Mr. Nixon arrived in California 12 days ago on a United Airlines flight. Warren was unable to say when the President would be returning to Washington.

Both the Secret Service and the Federal Aviation Administration have expressed misgivings over the security aspects of Mr. Nixon traveling like any other American citizen.
