

# House will vote to impeach: Percy

CHICAGO — Sen. Charles Percy said yesterday he has changed his mind the past month and now believes the House will vote for the impeachment of President Nixon.

"I have an ominous feel-

ing that we will have a trial of the President in the Senate — that the House will vote a bill of impeachment," Percy (Rep.-Ill.) told a news conference.

Percy, who has been assessing his own prospects as the GOP presidential candi-

date in 1976, said the reason for the shift in sentiment is the White House's reluctance to supply documents and tapes to special prosecutor Leon Jaworski and to the House Judiciary Committee considering impeach-

ment.  
"Nothing has eroded confidence in the White House more than its saying 'let's get it (Watergate) behind us' and then taking every action to delay and drag it out," Percy said.

"That discrepancy has not been lost on members of Congress."
