Schorr Tells of Tape

Connally-Nixon Milk Talk Report

New York

CBS correspondent Daniel Schorr reported last night that, according to congressional sources, on the morning of March 23, 1971, 15 minutes before meeting with dairy co-op leaders, President Nixon received a phone call from Treasury Secretary John B. Connally urging him to raise the milk subsidy — and stressing the dairy industry's campaign contribution potential.

Schorr, on the "CBS Evening News With Walter Cronkite," said a tape of that conversation is now in the hands of the House Judiciary Committee.

It reportedly supports information turned over by the Senate Watergate committee, Schorr said.

Schorr said CBS advised Connally's office in Houston, Tex., of this information two days ago but "he has not made himself available for comment."
