Agnew Coy About His New Office

Former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew has moved into a new suite of offices in an industrial park here. But he won't say what he's going to use it for.

"I don't understand why anybody cares what I'm going to be doing," Agnew told a reporter for the Annapolis Evening Capital. "I'm a private citizen."

Agnew added that he has no plans to make any announcement about the nature of his new occupation or grant interviews about it.

"You people in the media are always talking about a citizen's right to privacy. Don't I have that right?" he asked Tuesday.

Several persons whose offices are adjacent to Agnew's said the former vice president will use the \$1650-a-month three-room office for an import-export business.

Agnew. however, would say only: "You'll probably find out some day what I'm going to do here."

After his plea of no contest to a charge of income tax evasion and his resignation as vice president, Agnew was disbarred from the practice of law by the Maryland Court of Appeals.
