

**Judiciary Report
Printing Blocked**

The House refused yesterday to approve a resolution providing nearly \$1 million for printing the Judiciary Committee's hearing record and final report on its impeachment inquiry.

However, the measure is not dead. Because the vote technically was on whether to accept a Senate provision, it now goes back to the Senate.

Last week the House approved the resolution providing \$989,094 for printing 20,000 free copies of Judiciary Committee hearings and 500,000 free copies of its eventual impeachment report. The Senate tacked on a provision making additional copies available to the public at cost.
