Magazine Says Jaworski
Leans Toward Nixon Trial

The special Watergate prosecutor, Leon Jaworski, is contemplating prosecution of former President Richard M. Nixon because of the Watergate cover-up and leans toward a separate trial for him, Newsweek magazine reported Sunday. SEP

The article said that Mr. Jaworski was reportedly angry with both Congress and President Ford for handing him the job of deciding whether or not to prosecute Mr. Nixon. And in the absence of any political guidance from Capitol Hill or the White House, he is prepared to make his decision on merit alone and that almost certainly means the prosecution of the former President, Newsweek said.

Attributing its information to unnamed sources "close to the investigation," Newsweek said, "Jaworski's current thinking leans toward a separate trial for Nixon, instead of including him in the current case" of six Nixon aides scheduled for trial Sept. 30 on cover-up charges.
