Sirica Orders Lawyers To Submit Witness Lists

WASHINGTON, Sept. 4 (UPI)
United States District Judge
John J. Sirica ordered prosecution and defense lawyers today
to give him the names of witnesses they planned to call for
the Watergate cover-up trial by
Sept. 23, a week before the trial
begins.

He also ordered Leon Jaworski, the special Watergate prosecutor, to give the court and
defense counsel on Sept. 16
transcripts of all White House
tapes they planned to introduce
as evidence.

The orders summed up agreements reached at a pretrial conference last week and were issued by Judge Sirica "with the
consent of all parties."

They also contained the first
hint that Mr. Jaworski might
call some witnesses who were
less than willing to testify.
Judge Sirica gave Mr. Jaworski
until Sept. 16 to submit a legal
brief on the court's authority to
call "court witnesses" and to
give both the prosecution and
defense a chance at cross-examination.
