Group to Solicit Funds
For Nixon Law Fees

WASHINGTON, Oct. 3
(UPI) — Former President Richard M. Nixon has run up more than \$100,000 in legal expenses, a former aide says, but a fund has been set up to help him pay the debt.

Bruce Herschensohn said that the fund had been set up by a board of three trustees including Mr. Herschensohn, Rabbi Baruch Korff and George McLaughlin.

Rabbi Korff headed the National Citizens Committee for Fairness to the presidency and Mr. McLaughlin was an officer of the group.
