

Nixon Fund Bill

Washington

The Senate decided last night to put off until after the congressional elections the bill carrying \$200,000 for former President Richard M. Nixon's transition to private life.

The Nixon allotment is \$650,000 less than President Ford recommended.

The Senate debated the

appropriations measure for several hours with no member proposing to raise or lower the \$200,000 approved by the House.

Democratic leader Mike Mansfield finally won agreement to postpone debate on the bill until November 13 when the Senate returns from a recess.
