

Hearing Put Off for Woman In Vesco Call Girl Case

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 17 (UPI)—Government attorneys, without giving a reason, postponed indefinitely today the appearance of Alex Fleming before a Federal grand jury investigating charges that she supplied call girls to Robert L. Vesco, the fugitive financier, in Costa Rica.

Miss Fleming, also known as Betty Alexander and Betty Anderson, had told United States Senate investigators that she supplied call girls to Mr. Vesco.

Last month she was booked on charges of pimping and pandering following a local investigation into prostitution, but that arrest was not connected with Mr. Vesco.

Mr. Vesco fled the United States after he was indicted on charges stemming from a secret \$200,000 contribution to former President Richard M. Nixon's 1972 campaign.
