\$297,294 in Legal Bills

Run Up By Nixon Lawyers

WASHINGTON, March 28,

(AP)—Former President Richard M. Nixon's Washington lawyers have run up \$297,294.60 in legal bills so far, primarily for his effort to keep control of his Presidential tapes and papers, says Rabbi Baruch Korff.

Rabbi Korff, Mr. Nixon's fund raiser, disclosed the figure in reporting yesterday that public contributions had paid nearly half those bills, \$145,000, so far. He said the lawyers estimated that the total bills, barring unforeseen new legal action, would be between \$350,000 and \$400,000.

He said most of that was for handling Mr. Nixon's two major efforts, and the complex of cross suits connected with them, to get control of his presidential papers.
