Mrs. John Ehrlichman is eligible for the \$10,000-a year emergency employment job with the Seattle Symphony she has held since March 1, officials say.

City and King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium officials said Tuesday their final review of the job and her qualifications indicates that she is entitled to the job.

She will continue to hold the position of symphony education program coordinator, they said.

She said earlier that she needed the money for her family, adding, "John hasn't worked the past year, you know."

John Ehrlichman served as domestic advisor in the Richard M. Nixon administration, and faces a prison sentence for his Watergate cover-up activities.
