In his first prolonged public appearance since he left the White House, Richard M. Nixon played 18 holes of golf Thursday in San Clemente, Calif. His partner was Lieutenant Col Jack Brennan, his former military aide. Word spread and 40 people were waiting at the last hole, where Mr. Nixon chatted with some of them and posed for pictures. He used a golf cart but "did a lot of walking," the Shorecliffs course manager said, adding, "He seemed to favor his left leg, but his golf swing looked real good."
