Krogh Disbarred

OLYMPIA, Wash.—Former White House
"plumbers" chief Egil Krogh
Jr. was disbarred by the
State Supreme Court for his
role in the burglary of the
Los Angeles office of Daniel
Ellsberg's psychiatrist.

In a 7 to 2 finding, the
court agreed with the recommendation of the State
Bar Association that Krogh
should be barred from practicing law in Washington
state.

Krogh is now an aide to
Rep. Paul N. McCloskey (RCalif.).

A disbarred attorney may
seek reinstatement after

Calif.).

A disparred attorney may seek reinstatement after three years.

The court cited Krogh's conviction in U.S. District Court last year on a single charge of conspiracy against the rights of citizens in connection, with the Ellsberg burglary.
