To Nixon

Alexandria, Va.

An educational magazine with a worldwide circulation is forming the "Richard M. Nixon World Peace Foundation" to honor the former president's foreign policy accomplishments.

Officials of Quinto Lingo magazine, based in Alexandria, and claiming worldwide subscription of 30,000, said Tuesday the foundation is being established to "memorialize Nixon's contribution toward world peace." They said the group would issue annual "Nixon peace prize" awards.

Despite the Watergate problems which forced him to resign, magazine officials said, Mr. Nixon will be viewed by historians "as one of the greatest leaders of the 20th Century."
