Tokyo Rose Resolution

The Legislature asked President Ford yesterday to pardon and restore the American citizenship of Iva Toguri D'Anquino, the Tokyo Rose of World War II.

"It is not too much to ask a President who found it in his heart to pardon Richard Nixon to pardon this woman," said Assemblyman Ken Meade (Dem-Berkeley). The Assembly passed the resolution on a 60-to-0 vote.

The Senate, a few minutes later, passed the same measure on a 22 to-0 vote.
